

Dear Family,

#### "I am meek and humble of heart"

In the Bible, the yoke was a curved piece of wood called an 'ol. Essentially, a yoke was a harness used by oxen and other animals to ease the work of hauling a load. It was also meant as a designation of servitude and carrying the burden of a task or mission. In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter said: "why do you put God to the test now by imposing on the disciples the very burden that neither our ancestors nor we ourselves were strong enough to support? But we believe that we are saved in the same way as they are, through the grace of the Lord Jesus" (Acts15:7-11).

Contrary to the burden (yoke) of the Law that was heavy on people's shoulders, Jesus invited his followers to embrace the law of Love; to listen and walk with him for he is meek and humble of heart. In other words, everyone needs to be yoked to someone else, to walk together and do the same task. Jesus is the eternal Son of the Father who invites each one of us to be with him, learn from him and share in his mission. He

is the source of true wisdom. "All things have been handed over to me by my Father" (Mt.11:27).

Being obedient to His Father until death and death on a cross, Jesus experienced the filial intimacy and the joy of being one with His Father. By our baptism into his death and resurrection, he introduced us to that same intimacy with His Father and shared with us eternal life and happiness. We are only invited to learn from him for He is meek and humble of heart. He compels us to put into practice his commandments: "love one another as I have loved you"(Jn13:34).
